Mission:

The mission of the Fund is to encourage and affirm Christian undergraduate students by providing support for exploration and practice of their Christian faith through service and missions. Furthermore, the fund seeks to provide non-Christians, who are seeking to understand the faith, the opportunity to experience the Christian life through service.

Budget:

Approximately \$23,000 will be available each year for students who are selected.

Awards:

The amount of the awards will vary dependent upon the number of applicants and the projects submitted. The minimum amount awarded is \$500. Awards *are not* intended to fully fund any project.

Applications:

Applications will be available through the Chaplain's Office or may be downloaded from the Office of the Chaplain website under Financial Aid and Internships. Applications may also be received through email by contacting Elizabeth Orr at <u>orrej@wfu.edu</u>

The application deadlines are:

October 1: for Fall or Winter break February 1: Spring Break or May projects April 15: June – August projects

Selections:

The Rosser Fund committee will be composed of a University Chaplain, a Campus Minister, the Coordinator of Volunteer Services, a representative of the Dean's Office, one student representative, and one faculty representative. This committee will review the applications, make selections, and notify all applicants within two weeks of the application deadline. Consideration will be given to responses on the application, to personal fund-raising attempts, to apparent financial need, and to the reference letter. First-time applicants will be given priority.

Accountability: All students selected will submit a written report on the project after its completion.

Money awarded for trips not taken is to be returned to the Rosser Family Fund.
